



Parks Revitalization Program round two...

What's happening with our Parks Revitalization Program?

After being narrowly defeated in April of 2010, we've decided to go back to the drawing board and bring a new version of the plan back to the people. As of today we are anticipating a referendum in late Winter early Spring of 2013. After gathering much input from residents over the past two years, it was determined that some revisions needed to be made.

So what will be different this time?

- Kids Kingdom playground has been completed and was funded 50% by a state grant.
- The two projects will include;
 - 1) Cadigan and Town Park renovations and
 - 2) The funding to complete the 2 mile Still River Greenway (multi-use walking, jogging, bike path).
- The Town of Brookfield will be able to reduce the cost for the Town Beach building renovations by \$750,000 thanks to a grant from the State Bonding Commission.
- Further cost reductions to the Town Beach and Cadigan Park projects are being reviewed in response to input received from the community over the past two years.

How can you provide input?

I encourage all interested residents to keep their eyes open for opportunities to voice likes or dislikes in the coming months at a variety of public meetings.
