2. **Public Comment:** Steven Coppolino Sr., Anthony Coppolino and Steven Coppolino Jr. from Lakeville Towing expressed an interest in submitting an application to be put on the Brookfield towing rotation. They will be open for business in approximately 60 days. Chairperson Sparaco reviewed the process with them and encouraged them to submit the application when the business is operational.

  - a. Budget preparation has begun. Chief Montgomery and Major Purcell will be meeting with the First Selectman on December 8 for a budget discussion. Chief Montgomery reminded the Commissioners that the current Police contract expires on June 30, 2015.

- b. Dispatcher Charles Weeks has announced his retirement effective February 3, 2015.
  - c. Many shift changes began within the Department on December 1, 2014.
  - d. The drug collection box located at the Department has been emptied and its contents destroyed. There was a collection of 231 pounds of assorted drugs, much more than the previous years' collection of 125 pounds.
