



Happy Landings is located at 55 Whisconier Road (Route 133) in Brookfield, CT. It is 74 acres of open space with about 75% open fields and about 25% wooded. Trails cross throughout the property and lead up to the two windmills. The wells below the windmills were dug in 1890. The windmill closest to Whisconier Road was restored in 2012.

Happy Landing was purchased as open space by the Town of Brookfield from the Gereg family in 1999.

The view from Route 25, Whisconier Road, has changed very little since pre-revolutionary war times. These fields and windmills have become a remaining symbol of Brookfield's rural character. The property has a combination of rich soils, aquifer watershed with varied grasses, wetlands and hardwood forest.

In order to maintain the beauty of the property, the fields are hayed each year by a farmer and trails are maintained by Brookfield Parks & Recreation. The field paths are also used by the Brookfield High School Track Team.

We encourage townspeople to use the property for all types of passive recreation. We do have the following rules:

All Brookfield Open Space properties are:

- open from Dawn until Dusk*
- All dogs must be leashed and cleaned up after.*
- No motorized vehicles are allowed (except farming equipment with approval of Parks & Recreation & Conservation Commission)*
