The Town of Brookfield is requesting sealed bids for the construction of the Still River Greenway – Phase II project. Sealed bids will be received at the Parks and Recreation Department (2nd floor) of Town Hall, 100 Pocono Road, Brookfield, CT until **2:00pm on Wednesday, April 15, 2015**. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Bids will be opened and publically read aloud promptly after 2:00pm. All interested parties are invited to attend the bid opening.

Copies of the Bid Documents (Project Manual along with the Construction Plans) may be obtained upon deposit of \$100 per set (check made payable to the “Town of Brookfield”), at the Brookfield Town Hall, Parks and Recreation Department, starting **March 16, 2015, between 10:00am-3:00pm**, Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Interested bidders are limited to two sets of documents each. Deposits will only be returned if bid documents are returned to the Parks and Recreation Department, Brookfield Town Hall in good condition within 10 days of the date when bids are due.

There will be a **non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference on Monday, March 30, 2015 from 9:00am-10:00am** at the Brookfield Town Hall, Meeting Room 133. All questions concerning the bid documents must be directed in writing to Mr. Dennis DiPinto (DDiPinto@brookfieldct.gov / 203-775-7310), Director of Parks and Recreation, 100 Pocono Road, Brookfield, CT 06804, and be **received no later than 1:00pm on April 6, 2015**. Interested bidders are welcome to review the project site upon purchasing bid documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check from the bidder, or a bid bond for at least five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

The contract will be awarded based on the total base bid only.

The goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation in this Contract is **5%** of the final contract value and shall be performed by a ConnDOT approved DBE.

The minimum rates to be paid labor for the various classifications shall be in accordance with current Federal Wage Rate Determinations and the schedule of wages established by the State Labor Commissioner as provided in the General Statutes of Connecticut, as revised whichever is applicable.

Bidders will be required to provide references and evidence of experience in previous, similar work, and must carry appropriate insurance coverages.

The Town of Brookfield, CT and/or DOT in consideration with their Architect, reserve the right to reject any or all bids, and to accept informality in bids, and to award the contract to any one of the bidders regardless of the amount of the bid, if the interest of The Town of Brookfield, be promoted. The Town of Brookfield, CT intends to award the contract to the responsible and qualified bidder who has proposed the lowest Contract Sum and reserves the right to negotiate with said qualified bidder.

No bidder may withdraw his or her bid within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Town of Brookfield and/or DOT reserves the right to reject bids and to waive irregularities.
