Sealed Bids for the supply of waterline pipe materials will be received by William Davidson, First Selectman at the office of the First Selectman, Town of Brookfield (hereinafter referred to as OWNER), 100 Pocono Road, Brookfield, Connecticut, 06804, until **11 a.m. on April 30, 2013**, and at that time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The project is the construction of approximately 1,243 linear feet of 16 inch water line in Federal Road.

Bidders may not withdraw their Bids for a period of ninety days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.

Bid will be awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible/qualified bidder for the 16 inch waterline as determined by the OWNER. However, the OWNER reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids, to waive technicalities, and to award the contract as will best serve the sole interest of the OWNER.
