PHASE 3-FEDERAL ROAD**

Sealed Bids for the General Contract for construction of Southern Waterline-Phase 3-Federal Road will be received by William Davidson, First Selectman at the office of the First Selectman, Town of Brookfield (hereinafter referred to as OWNER), 100 Pocono Road, Brookfield, Connecticut, 06804, until **10 a.m. on April 30, 2013**, and at that time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The project is the construction of approximately 1,243 linear feet of 16 inch water line in Federal Road. A portion of the water line will be installed by pipe jacking.

Contract Documents may be obtained at the office of CCA, LLC, 40 Old New Milford Road, Brookfield, Connecticut, 06804. Each set may be purchased for a non-refundable fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), in the form of cash, certified check or cashier's check payable to CCA, LLC. Electronic copies can be purchased for a non-refundable fee of forty dollars (\$40.00). Any questions concerning the bid documents should be directed in writing to Mr. Steven C. Bidders requesting Contract Documents by mail shall include an additional non-refundable fee in the amount of \$15.00 per set payable to CCA, LLC to cover costs of handling and mailing.

Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5 percent (5%) of the total Bid.

Bidders may not withdraw their Bids for a period of ninety days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100 percent Performance and Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the OWNER.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

Wage rates for this Project are **NOT** subject to the minimum wage rates as per State of Connecticut, Department of Labor.

Bid will be awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible/qualified bidder for the 16 inch waterline as determined by the OWNER. However, the OWNER reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids, to waive technicalities, and to award the contract as will best serve the sole interest of the OWNER.
