Beginning Sewing

The first class will meet at Jo-Ann Fabrics in Brookfield (143 Federal Road) where the instructor will help you pick out a pattern and the materials that you will need for the project that you'd like to complete. Additional materials cost will depend upon the project and fabric you select, but are estimated at \$40-100. Class size is limited to 5 for lots of individual attention.
