

Harris Linear Park

Trail Highlights -

Harris Linear Park contains two main loop trails which wind their way through wooded and wetland areas. The primary trail begins near Town Hall on the opposite side of the soccer fields where a "Trail Entrance" sign is posted. The trail starts out adjacent to the Still River by a canoe landing dock. Less than a half mile into the trip hikers will come across a trail junction and gazebo, an ideal place to relax on the way in or out of the park. The park's two loop trails begin and end at this gazebo. The park also features a long wooden boardwalk which traverses a wetland area near the banks of the Still River. A longer trail following the Still River all the way to Danbury is still in the planning stages.
