<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: After discussion, a motion was made by R. Roudenis, seconded by Chairman G.

Rooney, to approve and recommend to a Town Meeting, the following budget for the American Rescue

Plan Act (ARPA):

A motion was made by R. Roudenis, seconded by Vice Chairman E. Koch, to approve and recommend to a Town Meeting and Referendum, the following operating budget for fiscal year 2022-23:

Town operations	\$20,683,214
School operations	48,666,148
Debt service	6,264,450
Capital projects	2,132,837
Total	\$77,746,649

as outlined and described in the operating budget being submitted to the Town Clerk. This budget represents an increase of 3.15% over the mill rate over the prior fiscal year (adjusted to an

equivalent mill rate after the revaluation) and anticipates a mill rate of 25.88 for fiscal year 2022-23. Motion carries unanimously.

A motion was made by R. Roudenis, seconded by M. Cappiello, to approve and recommend to a Town Meeting and Referendum, an amount not to exceed the following for the capital budgets for fiscal year 2022-23:

as outlined and described in the capital budget being submitted to the Town Clerk. And to approve financing an amount not to exceed these amounts with the issuance of bonds and/or temporary notes in accordance with the standard bonding and borrowing resolution for said appropriations.

Included in the various capital projects is \$205,000 bonded for a match to the Street Scape Phase 6 project. The total project, in an amount not to exceed \$3,965,766, is also approved subject to obtaining final approval on the State and utility funding.

Motion carries unanimously.
