<u>BOE Financial Report</u> – BOE Chair B. Belden gave the Board of Finance an update on the BOE Financial Report.

<u>Town Finance Director Report</u> -Town Finance Director M. Marien gave the Board of Finance an overview of the Revenue and Expenditures for the month of April 2023. She also reported on ARPA, Capital Projects Status and provided an Audit update.

Vice Chairman E. Koch made a motion seconded by M. Cappiello, to move the Police Outside Services Fund Requests, under New Business, next on the agenda. Motion carries 4-0.

Secretary B. Ruocco recused herself from the Police Outside Services Fund Request – Used Motorcycle Purchase vote.

• <u>Police Outside Services Fund Request – Used Motorcycle Purchase</u> – Chris Campbell was present for this discussion

A motion was made by Vice Chairman E. Koch, seconded by R. Rouodenis, that we appropriate \$20,400 for the purchase of a 2016 Motorcycle and related safety equipment for the police motorcycle unit, as outlined in Chief John Puglisi's memo dated April 5, 2023. Motion carries 3-0-1.

• Police Outside Services Fund Request – Hummingbird Sonar Unit - A motion was made by Vice Chairman E. Koch, seconded by M. Cappiello, to appropriate \$4,000 for the purchase of a Hummingbird SOLIX 15 Sonar Unit and accessories order to replace the unrepairable sonar unit and provide needed equipment for the Brookfield Police Dive Team operators, as outlined in Chief John Puglisi's memo dated May 3, 2023. Motion carries 4-0.

- <u>April Budget Transfers</u> A motion was made by Vice Chairman E. Koch, seconded by R. Roudenis, that the Board of Finance approve the inter department transfers that were presented from the Board of Selectmen to the Board of Finance in the amount of \$87,501.98. Motion carries 4-0.
