At the April 6th Board of Education Meeting:

Mrs. Dymond, Principal of Center Elementary School, presented this month's Student Spotlight, by showcasing the Digital Portfolios that students and staff are piloting at CES. The goal of the digital portfolios is to encourage students to be self-navigating learners by intentionally fostering curiosity and developing a growth mindset. Students must learn skills and strategies for goal-setting, action planning, accepting and incorporating feedback, understanding success criteria, identifying appropriate strategies, searching out and managing resources, and self-reflection. The digital portfolios give students an opportunity to show their progress in a different format and build self-efficacy, and also gives parents a chance to see progress throughout the year. CES teachers Heidi Natalino and Michelle Tuck are pioneering the use of digital portfolios by giving the students instruction, coaching and support to harness students' natural curiosity and content knowledge, and also by providing conditions for students to grow their self-efficacy through their confidence in their abilities.
