

**TOWN OF BROOKFIELD
CODE OF ETHICS ORDINANCE**

An amendment to the Code of Ethics Ordinance was adopted by the Brookfield Board of Selectmen on August 2, 2021, and shall become effective on the twenty-first (21) day following its adoption and publication. The Ordinance in its entirety can be obtained from the Town Clerk's office or on the Town website: www.brookfieldct.gov and the new section is as follows:

Section F. Awarding of Town Contracts. No officer/employee shall participate in the selection, award or administration of a Town contract if he or she has a real or apparent conflict of interest. Such a conflict of interest would arise when the officer/employee, any member of his or her immediate family, his or her partner, or an organization, which employs or is about to employ any of the parties indicated herein, has a financial or other interest in or a tangible personal benefit from a firm considered for a contract. The officer/employee of the Town must neither solicit nor accept gratuities, favors or anything of monetary value from contractors or parties to subcontracts.
