# November 3, 2020 Election FAQ's

#### Can I vote at the Polls?

Yes, polling locations will be open from 6am-8pm on November 3, 2020. Verify your polling location here.

#### Do I have to Vote by Absentee Ballot?

No. Your polling location will be open on November 3, 2020 from 6:00am – 8:00pm

### Will I automatically get a ballot in the mail?

No. Eligible voters must complete a <u>request for absentee ballot application</u> and submit it to the Town Clerk to receive an absentee ballot.

#### How can I register to vote?

You can register to vote here.

## Can I vote by Absentee Ballot?

Yes. Around mid-September, an absentee ballot application will be arriving to the address the Registrars have on file. If you do not receive an application in the mail, you can download one form our website. A COVID-19 modified version can be found <a href="https://example.com/here.">here.</a>\*\*\*Apply early and mail your ballot back quickly. Make sure your ballot arrives on time!\*\*\*

#### Is it too early to apply for an absentee ballot?

No! You can <u>apply for an absentee ballot</u> for November and return it to the Town Clerk's office now; however, please do not send in more than one application.

### Where Can I return my application for and absentee Ballot?

You can return your application to Town Hall via the Official Ballot Drop Box located directly outside of Town Hall or via mail to Brookfield Town clerk, PO Box 5106, Brookfield, CT 06804

## Can I get a Ballot now?

Absentee Ballots become available on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020.

### Can I get an absentee ballot to my college or snow-bird residence?

Yes. Please print your mailing address legibly on your <u>application</u> to ensure total accuracy. College Students, please keep in mind that your campus mail service will add an additional delay in the return of your ballot.

What if I applied for an absentee ballot and my college dismissed all on campus residents due to COVID-19?

Upon change of your requested mailing address, please contact the Town Clerk's office at 203.775.7313/townclerk@brookfieldct.gov.

## Can I avoid the Post Office and return my absentee ballot in person?

Yes. You can return your ballot to the secure ballot drop box located directly outside of Town Hall 24 hours a day.

## I am a military/overseas voter. How can I apply for an absentee ballot?

Military and overseas voters can apply using the Federal Post Card Application.

## How do I know you got my application for absentee ballot?

Please email <u>townclerk@brookfieldct.gov</u> if you would like to verify receipt of your application. Please be patient with our response time due to the increased number of absentee ballot applications we are receiving.



IMPORTANT! TO ENSURE THAT YOUR BALLOT WILL BE RECEIVED ON TIME, PLEASE PLACE YOUR BALLOT INTO BOTH THE INNER AND OUT ENVELOPES AND PLACE YOUR BALLOT INTO THE SECURE DROP BOX LOCATED IN YOUR MUNICIPALITY. ONCE DEPOSITED IN THE SECURE DROP BOX YOUR BALLOT IS CONSIDERED RECEIVED BY YOUR MUNICIPALITY. YOUR BALLOT SHOULD BE DEPOSITED IN THE SECURE DROP BOX NO LATER THAN 8 P.M. ON November 3, 2020
